## **More Top 3 Finishers for Carina Leagues Triathlon Club Athletes**

Ryan Isaac, 16 of Carindale, was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 16-19 years male division at the Luke Harrop Memorial Triathlon held at the Gold Coast Broadwater on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2007 in 1 hour 3 minutes and 22 seconds in the 750 m swim, 20 km bike and 5 km run event.

In the same distance at this race Emma Kline, 16 of Bulimba, was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the 16-19 years female division in 1 hour 17 minutes and 23 seconds.

Elle Salthouse, 13 of Balmoral, was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the U/14 girls Enticer triathlon in 33 minutes and 20 seconds for the 300 m swim, 10 km bike and 2.5 km run.

"It was great to see Ryan and Elle race well today by finishing in the top 3 of their age group while in heavy training for the National Secondary Schools Triathlon Championships to be held on the 21<sup>st</sup> March in Canberra," Triathlon Coach Warwick Dalziel said.

"In Saturday's elite men's race won by world number 1, Brad Kahlefeldt, we had ITU junior clubs members Josh Maeder and Travis Gaskin compete. Both young athletes handled themselves well in the elite race but this race showed them that they have a fair amount of training ahead if they wish to compete with the world's best triathletes", Warwick added.

The Carina Leagues Triathlon Club had 17 members compete across the elite, age group and enticer races at the Luke Harrop Memorial Triathlon in support of club patron, Loretta Harrop.

"All club members particularly enjoy this event on the fast course that the Gold Coast Broadwater provides and were glad the race was successful for all involved", Warwick added.
